







WHAT EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE WILL I NEED?

Many software development occupations require a bachelor's degree for entry, a requirement reflected in 67% of postings. A master's degree is demanded in 19% of postings. Additionally, workers with two to three years of experience are requested in 23% of postings while advanced workers with four to six years of experience are also highly demanded.


