





 Up to 100K in matching funds for technical assistance projects

• 50/50 cost share

 Funds can be used on single or multiple projects

Eligibility:

Located in one the identified eleven Southeast Michigan Counties

Less than 500 employees (in total for all locations)

At least 10% of annual business revenue from the mobility sector

currently or within the past 5 years*

*Companies the do not have 10% annual revenue, but demonstrate a critical potential to address a particular need in the advanced mobility supply chains may also be eligible.
